DATES, TIMES & SCHEDULES

The program will run July 8 – August 2, 2019. Students are required to attend in person from 8:00 AM - Noon. Students are expected to be in their seats by 8:15 AM. They will be given 5-10 minute breaks every hour and released at 11:40 AM to go over for lunch, which is served at Stratton Elementary.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

Students must attend every day for the entire summer program or until their course is complete. If a student will miss a day, the parent/guardian must call the above number to notify staff of their absence.

COURSE COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS

Students must complete their course by the beginning of the 2019-20 school year. If a student does not complete his/her course by midnight on Tuesday, August 27, 2019, the student will be charged \$100. Courses of students who attend daily during July will be left open so that they can be completed online during August.

TRANSPORTATION

The District is providing modified busing services for students involved in the program. Buses will arrive at Stratton Elementary at 8:00 AM and depart at 12:00 PM. Students not arriving or departing at these times will need to make their own transportation arrangements. The latest students may be picked up is 12:15 PM.

MEALS

The District provides breakfast between 7:45-8:15 AM and lunch between 11:40 AM-noon daily. These meals are free for all children ages 1-18 years.
